Things to know

- Minimum age: 16 years
- All levels, from beginners to C2 level
- Group size: 4-12 students
- One lesson equals 45 minutes

At a glance: in our intensive 20 course you...

- have 20 lessons per week. Your German class will take place from Monday to Friday, from 9.30 a.m. to 12.45 p.m. with a 15 minute break included.

- can start your tuition any Monday, if you have studied German before. For complete beginners, we start courses once a month (see page 3 for starting dates).
- can learn German from A1 to C2 level.

All students can begin with their CIP® class any Monday, except on public holidays.

Your tuition usually starts on Monday between 8.00 a.m. and 10.00 a.m. All course materials are included in the price.

One lesson equals 45 minutes. For CIP® 40 or CIP® 50 lunch together with your trainer can be booked for just 50,00 € per day.

Telc and TestDaF examination



Telc

With a telc certificate (according to the reference framework of the EU Commission), you can document your current knowledge of German - an advantage for every application that gives you career opportunities.

We are an official telc examination centre and offer the exam to students that book a German course with us for the following levels: A1, B1, B2, C1 and C1 Hochschule. Each examination consists of a written part (reading, writing and listening) and an oral exam. Please let us know in your booking form if you are interested in taking an exam.

TestDaF examination

inlingua Berlin is also an official TestDaF examination centre. This is the examination required by those seeking entrance to a German university.

Accommodation

Accommodation is a very important part of your language course and holiday. Only if you feel comfortable can you really enjoy your stay with us. If you like to be in company, we would recommend choosing homestay.

Homestay

A great way to experience authentic city life and culture. Students get involved in everyday life, participating in excursions and discussions. This type of accommodation helps you learn German most effectively, and is recommended for all those who like being with other people and who wish to get an insight into Berlin life. Our host families are as diverse as Berlin itself, and along with 'traditional' families, there are just as many singles and single parents looking forward to welcoming you!

You have your own room, where you can have all the privacy you need. All other facilities such as the kitchen and bathroom are shared with the family members. Of course we choose all our host families carefully, and quality checks are carried out through personal visits. The choice of boarding is yours.

A single room with...

- self-catering: you buy and prepare your own meals and have access to the kitchen
- breakfast: breakfast will be served and ideally you will have it together with the host
- half-board: breakfast and dinner will be served, and ideally you will have it together with the host

Arrival and departure

Arrivals take place on Sundays and departures take place on Saturdays. Other arrangements are possible upon request.

Location

Homestay accommodation is located throughout the city but is generally no more than a 35 - 50 minute public transport journey from the school.

Please fill out our online enrolment form, which you can find on www.germancoursesberlin.com under contact > enrolment form.

If this isn't a convenient way for you to enrol, then you can also fill out the booking form on the right hand side and send a scan to info@inlingua-berlin.de

You will then receive an email from us with the course confirmation and the invoice. To secure your spot, a deposit of 15% or 200,00 €, whichever is the greater, should be transferred into our bank account. The course fee is payable in full no later than three weeks before the course commences.

Should you need an invitation letter for the visa, the whole amount must be transferred into our bank account before sending the document to you.

Placement test

If you are not a complete beginner, we kindly ask that you take our online placement test before your arrival, to find an appropriate course for you. For complete beginners, we have specific start dates; Please find the start date suitable for you on page 3.

If you need to reach a certain level but are not sure where you stand at the moment, you can also take the placement test before your booking, so we can tell you your level and for how long you would need to take a course to reach your goal.
